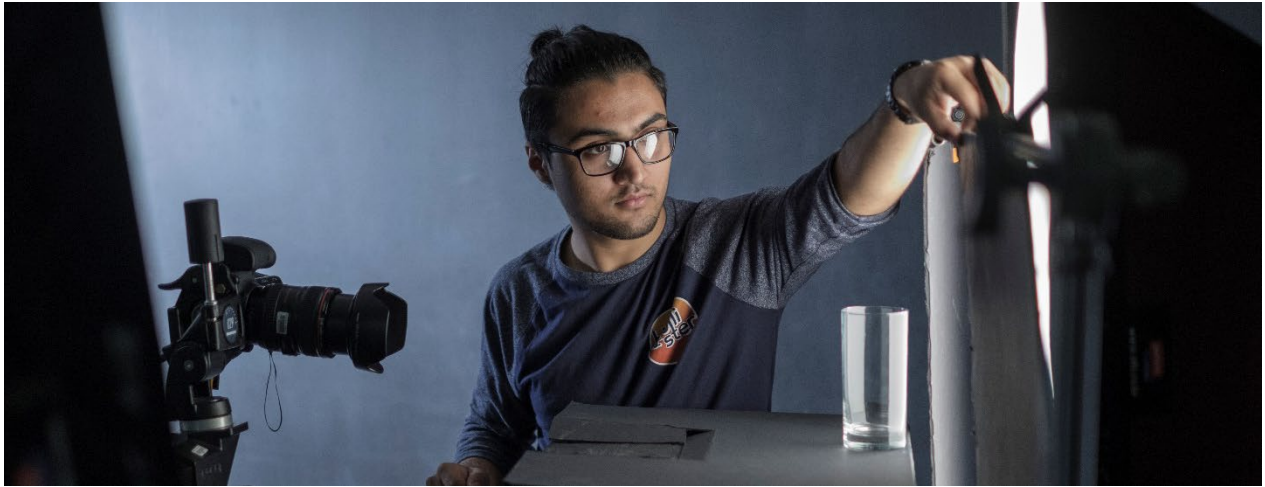

Core competencies and skills

- Using Adobe Creative Cloud (Photoshop, Dreamweaver, Lightroom, Premiere, InDesign, After Effects).
- Using Capture One Pro Software.
- Using digital single-lens reflex cameras and medium format digital and video cameras.
- Working with advanced strobe and LED studio/location lighting.
- Organizing work to meet deadlines and expectations.
- Demonstrating people skills when working with a production team on set.
- Applying analytical and critical thinking skills with the research of relevant visual and textual references.

Work term availability

- Summer work term (May – August), taken at the end of Year 3.

Work term capabilities

- Developing concepts and designs for images that communicate a client's message.
- Organizing logistics of all aspects of photography sessions: casting, equipment, sets, etc.
- Planning and executing steps for studio and location photography.
- Using a variety of camera and lighting equipment (lighting systems, radio slaves, lighting modifiers, tripods, micro-heads, DSLR, digital cameras, etc.)
- Using Capture One, Lightroom and Adobe Photoshop in post-production.
- Applying attention to detail while finishing and presenting photographic work.
- Understanding copyright legislation as it pertains to image licensing.
- Basic invoicing and estimating for clients.
- Appropriately using legal consents, models, and property releases.
